- Serves as a leader (point person) to provide an insight to AFE, on issues relating to the education and development and membership as a whole.
- Assists the officers in providing oversight on AFE's future direction in meeting the goals of the organization and core area growth.
- Looks for sound and innovative solutions on behalf of the organization.
- Participates actively in Board meetings (face to face and Teleconference) and the governance of the association through formulation, review and execution oversight of the business decisions guiding the overall direction of AFE.
- Represents AFE to academia
- Researches and maintains currency on industry teaching and learning trends, reporting them to the Board with recommendations for policy in areas of benefit to the association
- Identifies and recruits new members to strengthen the association
